Our goal is to assist individuals in developing social functioning and a sense of wellbeing in a safe and supportive environment. **The Recovery Education Center (REC)** is an educational program that focuses on preparing you for success toward your life goals.

Classes meet Monday through Friday from 9:15 a.m. to 12 p.m. or from 1 p.m. to 3:45 p.m. Topics include:

- Emotional Management
- Wellness Recovery Action Plan (WRAP®)
- Boundaries/Healthy Relationships
- Effective Communication
- Mindfulness/Relaxation
- Addiction/Codependency
- Spirituality
- Healthy Social Supports

Enjoy life again by eliminating or managing negative thinking, low self-esteem and depression. The **REC** program is appropriate for those wishing to learn skills to prevent relapse from addiction and/or debilitating symptoms of mental illness.
